**There is always constant pull and push between market structure and new data coming in the market why I like to cover BOTH** here PPE Pivots /Price Action /Events

This relationship is important to grasp once understood it becomes far easier to trade.When I say go over the calendar its designed so you mentally understand the events and how that plays out in the market. You can short cut this by just looking at the calendar but that's like trying to learn guitar by watching someone else play instead of you.You wont develop physical finger memory.Trading is same you are building in your mind trading steps physical memory...

Understanding this allows position sizing. If set up is great but price is ranging in 50pip you can go bigger lots if its longer swings maybe reduce lots and hit it multiple times on small rallies/dips. Its adapting to the pair movement why I never set fix lot size but do have max cut out size.

We dont sell Pivot zone S61-S100 that goes selling rallies. Should of been buying dips! You might get away once twice but its not high probability way to trade.

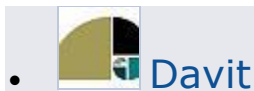

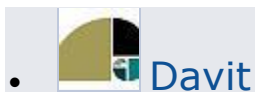
