

The two EA's go in your Expert's folder.

You use them when you have identified Legs 1 & 2 and are waiting for Leg 3 to trigger the trade. Their purpose is to save you having to constantly monitor the chart for a trade trigger, once you have identified a potential setup.

In an up trend, you have identified Legs 1 & 2 and are awaiting a fall back to the trend line to trigger the Leg 3 BUY. You drag **David's 4H Trendline BUY EA by Steve Hopwood** onto the chart.

In a down trend, you have identified Legs 1 & 2 and are awaiting a rise back to the trend line to trigger the Leg 3 SELL. You drag **David's 4H Trendline SELL EA by Steve Hopwood** onto the chart.

The ea monitors the market and attempts to send the trade when the price reaches the trendline.

You need a trend line with the same name as the TrendLineName input, which defaults to TL1, so:

- draw a trendline (or use one already drawn)
- double click the line to select it
- hold the mouse over the line, right-click and select "TrendLine properties"
- select the Common tab
- change the Name to match that in your TrendLineName input.

The inputs, with their defaults, are:

- **Lot=0.01**; take a guess.
- **TrendLineName="TL1"**; explained above
- **StopLoss=50**; take another guess
- **BeAggressive=true**; trades as David does, triggering the trade as soon as the L3 event occurs.
- **BeConservative=false**; waits for the start of a new candle before looking for the trade
- **MagicNumber=0**; allows you to use mptm to manage the trades if you want to. If you are only trading this system on the account, then leave this at zero.
- **TradeComment=""**; any comment you wish to add to the trade.
- **CriminalIsECN=false**; set this to true if your criminal insists on you sending tp and sl as a second part of the order. Change criminals.
- **ReEntryLinePips=200**; this is Nanningbob's 2.4.2 recovery system. Read about it in his thread to work out what this is all about.
- **ReEntryLineColour=Turquoise**;
- **TakeProfit=50**; be brave. Take another guess.
- **UseAtrTp=false**; set this to true to use Atr to set your tp instead of using a 'hard' tp. Do not use it unless you know what you are doing,
- **AtrTpPeriod=14**;
- **AtrTpTimeFrame=0**;
- **AtrTpMultiplier=3**;

Mt4 is a crap platform – that is why the criminals let us have it for free. At the drop of a hat, it will allow an ea to send a zillion trades in the matter of seconds. To guard against this happening, these ea's turn themselves off once they have attempted to send a trade,

whether this attempt was successful or not. **Remove them from the chart immediately they have sent an order; they will be reactivated on a platform restart.**

Remember to remove the ea if it has not triggered a trade at the end of your trading session.
